


The Commonwealth Governor's School

Overview

- Established in 1998
- Six total sites across four counties with 12 participating high schools
- School within a school model
 - Half day program at 2 different sites within Spotsylvania County focused on core content areas (mathematics, science, English, social studies)
 - Riverbend HS
 - Serves Riverbend HS
 - Serves Chancellor HS
 - Spotsylvania HS
 - Serves Spotsylvania HS
 - Serves Courtland HS
 - Serves Massaponax HS

- Astronomy & Equations of Ellipses

- Interdisciplinary approach to learning
 - Focused on helping students see the connections between content areas and learning big picture concepts
 - Access to real-world, relevant learning experiences in all content areas

Eligibility

- Gifted or highachieving students
 AND highly motivated learners
- Students in grades 9-12
- Must successfully complete Algebra I by the end of the spring in 8th grade to be eligible to apply





Field Experiences

 6-8 field experiences per grade level per year; 1-2 per subject area









Culminating Project



- Research project
- Focused on student's personal interest
- Receive an elective credit at the conclusion of 12th grade
- Opportunity to work with an expert in selected field of research
- Intersession model that allows students to work exclusively on research throughout the school year



- Application opens online December 11
- Application closes January 12 @ 11:59pm
- Testing Window Weeks of January 15-26
 - Achievement testing will be administered in reading comprehension and mathematics to all applicants.
 - Ability testing will be administered to any student who has not completed one in the past 12 months.
- Interview/Project Date February 3 (virtual)
- Acceptance Notification February 20
